

Proof of English Language Ability

Admission Requirements for the Degree Programs at the UAS Technikum Wien

If you are interested in studying a degree program taught in English at the UAS Technikum Wien and you do not have a secondary school degree or university degree in English, you must provide evidence that you have an adequate command of English.

The required language skills of the respective degree program must correspond to at least level B2 of the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages" in all four sub-areas (listening, reading, speaking, writing) and must be proven by an appropriate certificate. It is recommended that as part of the application process you acquire the necessary certificate, preferably at one of the following institutions:

- Cambridge Certificate of English First (FCE) – min. score 170
- Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English (CAE)
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE)
- Cambridge Business English Certificate Higher (BEC)
- International English Language Testing System (IELTS Academic) – min. score 6.0
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) – min. score PBT 530 / CBT 200 / iBT 70
- Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) – min. score 700
- UNIcert II
- PTE Academic – min. score 54

Note: Applicants with school education or university degree completed in the required language need **no proof** of language skills.
