

Support Criteria for Open Access Publication Fees

To receive support for open access publication fees, the eligibility criteria outlined here must be met, whereby the granting of funds takes place until further notice according to the principle "first come, first served".

1. Support will be offered to

- a. Access articles in **Open Access Journals (Golden Way)**, which must be listed in the [Directory of Open Access Journals](#). This implies that quality assurance measures (e.g., peer review) are performed, articles are readily available upon publication, and distribution is permitted (e.g., under a Creative Commons license).
 - b. **Hybrid models:** Paying for open access to articles in subscription journals.
2. Support from the UAS Technikum Wien will only be forthcoming if there is no other possibility of financing (for example, from a third-party funded project, department budget).
 3. The publication must be co-ordinated with and confirmed by the project management or head of department (if available).
 4. The submitting author or corresponding author is employed at the UAS Technikum Wien.¹
 5. In the publication or on the website of the journal, the organizational affiliation "UAS Technikum Wien" or "University of Applied Sciences Technikum Wien" is noted.
 6. The article will be made available to the institutional repository of UAS Technikum Wien (ePub) in a suitable format including metadata, links etc. (Go-live in the winter semester 2023/24). In addition the full text should also be made available via Zenodo, the multidisciplinary open repository of CERN (<https://zenodo.org/>).
 7. A maximum of € 1,500 per essay will be funded.

¹ "Submitting author" is the person submitting the entry. "Corresponding author" is the person who is the official contact person regarding the entry submitted to the publisher
